As we look forward to the year ahead, we remain dedicated to providing an exceptional education that honors the unique light within every student. Together, we are shaping a brighter future for all.

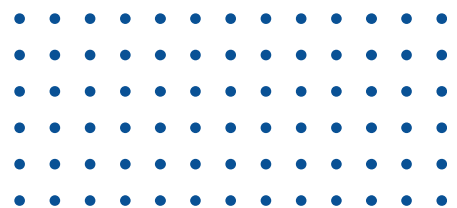

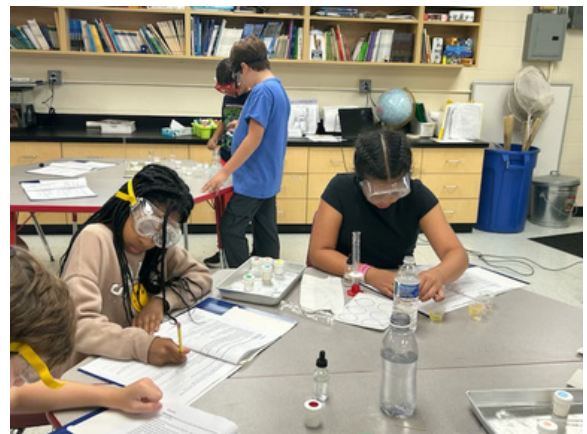


SCIENCE LAB AND SCIENCE PROGRAM GIFTS

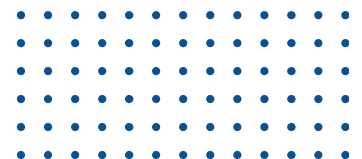
