For Children in Rising Play School (age 3 by September 1st and toilet trained) through Rising Sixth Grade

July 20th, July 27th, August 3rd, and August 10th**

\$375 per child per full 5 day week

\$300 per child for weeks of June 15 or 29 (4 day weeks)

\$80 per child per day for partial weeks

A \$10 reduction will be made for each additional full week.

EXCITING NEW OPPORTUNITY!

As part of our regular school year curriculum for the past several years, West Chester Friends School offers Forest Fridays. Kindergarten and an additional class (of First through Fifth graders) leave campus every Friday to investigate and explore outdoor learning at local preserves (ChesLen, Hibernia, etc.)

Forest Camp will extend these Friday outings for all five days of three separate weeks this summer! – June 8th, July 13th and August 3rd!

Each of these three weeks will now be available for students in rising 1st Grade through rising 6th grade.

Students are dropped off and picked up at ChesLen Preserve, 1199 Cannery Road, Coatesville, PA and will spend the day exploring nature with our experienced teachers.

Note that no early care or after care is available with this option. Camp hours are 9 am until 3 pm.
